Learning Labs are a valuable resource held after school every Tuesday and Thursday until 4:00. Learning Lab teachers will help you study for tests, work on projects and other assignments, and even tutor you individually if needed. You can also complete make-up work and form study groups with friends. Learning labs are for all students if you want a little individual help, or if you just want to do better in your classes.



When are Learning Labs?

Why should kids go to a Learning Lab?

- Prepare for a test
- Complete make-up work
- Get extra help

- Study with friends

Where are Learning Labs?

- **Tuesdays**
 - English – Rm. 104, Mr. Hershey or Rm. 102, Mrs. Upton
 - Social Studies – Rm. 227, Mrs. Boyer
- **Thursdays**
 - Science – Rm. 235, Mrs. Flick
 - Math – Rm. 129, Ms. Evans
 - Learning support – Rm. 210, Ms. Mead

Who can go to Learning Labs?

- Learning Labs are for **all** students!
- Any student may choose to go to any learning lab. If you need materials (like a test) from your teacher, you must check with your teacher to make sure that they give the materials to the Learning Lab teacher, or you can bring the materials with you.
- Teachers may assign students to learning lab to make up missed assignments or for extra help.
- NOTE: Learning Lab is not detention or a disciplinary option, unless arranged by administration.

What Learning Lab can I go to?

- You may go to **any** learning lab. If you need specific help with a subject, try to go to that subject's day. For example, if you want extra help with math, go to the math Learning Lab. If you are just finishing a project, go to any Learning Lab.

How do I get home after Learning Lab?

- You can arrange to be picked up at school at 4:00 P.M. There is also a Tutoring Bus available on learning lab days, but you must have a bus pass from the teacher in order to ride. The buses leave the high school at 4:15 and will drop you off near your home.

What if I miss a Learning Lab that was assigned by my teacher?

- The teacher may choose to give you a zero for the assignment. These Learning Labs are to help you be successful in school. Take advantage of this opportunity!
